Keep Your Account Active

We realize that sometimes accounts are simply forgotten. Other times, they are not forgotten but are being held on to for a future use. Whatever the reason, we are glad that you are a member and hope that we will continue to be able to service your financial needs through our numerous loan and savings products and services.

However, it is important to keep your account with us active. An account is subject to the monthly low participation fee of \$10 if there is no activity during a six month period and combined share account balances (Regular Share, Checking, Money Marketing, Christmas Club and Vacation Club) are less than \$200. This fee will not be charged for accountholders under 18 years of age nor will it apply to Teen and Kid accounts. Members who have a certificate of deposit, IRA or loan are also excluded.

An easy way to avoid the fee is to keep your account active with frequent deposits and transactions or by adding additional products and services.

5 Tips to Stay Safe at the ATM

- 1. Keep Your Eyes Open
 Be aware of people around the ATM.
 Use your body or hand to block your
 PIN from anyone standing behind
 you. If you see something or someone suspicious, go to another ATM.
 If the ATM looks like it has been
 tampered with, find another ATM.
- 2. Be Prepared
 Before you even step up or pull up to an ATM, have your stuff ready. Prepare your transaction beforehand, away from the ATM. Pocket the cash immediately, along with your card and receipt. Wait until you are away from the ATM to count money or write in your register.
- 3. Don't Ask a Stranger
 Don't accept assistance from a
 stranger or a store clerk. Go to a
 safe place and call the institution that
 owns the ATM if you need help with
 the machine.
- 4. Drive (Up) Safely
 Keep your car running, lock your
 doors and roll up your windows
 (except the one you need) when you
 are at a drive up ATM.
- 5. Don't Hesitate to Cancel At any time during a transaction, you can press Cancel, make sure your information is gone, and walk away. If someone does try to take your money or your card, let them. Your money is replaceable. You are not.
